- Soil compaction

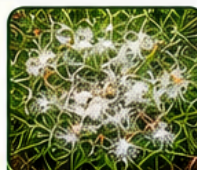


EARLY SIGNS OF FUNGUS

The sooner you spot it, the easier it is to stop. Watch for these common signs:



Brown or tan patches



White, cottony fungus growth



Discolored grass blades



Circular rings in the lawn



PREVENTION IS YOUR BEST DEFENSE

Follow these simple steps to prevent fungus before it takes hold.

MOW PROPERLY

Keep your mower blades sharp and mow at the proper height for your grass type.

2



WATER SMART

Water deeply and infrequently. Avoid watering late in the evening.

3



IMPROVE AIRFLOW

Space plants and shrubs to allow good air circulation across your lawn.

4



REDUCE THATCH

Core aeration helps reduce thatch and allows air, water and nutrients to reach the roots.

5



FEED YOUR LAWN

A healthy, well-fed lawn is more resistant to fungus problems.
